

Thursday 14th July **WINDSOR**
Attractions in the town include Windsor Castle which is the official residence of the Queen, the Changing of the Guard, and St George's Chapel, where King Henry VIII is buried.

Sunday 17th July **LONDON: WESTMINSTER**
